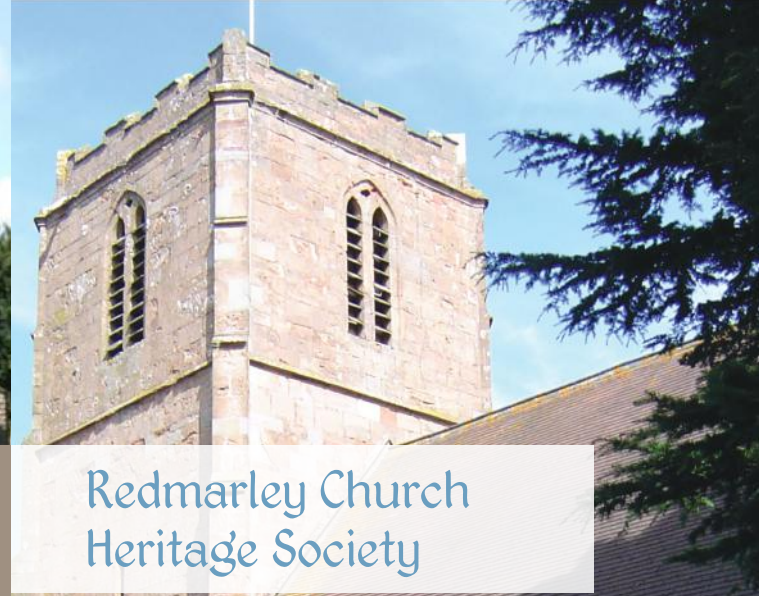

Time has taken its toll over the years and a sympathetic restoration of the building, especially the tower which is on the English Heritage AT RISK register, is now essential.

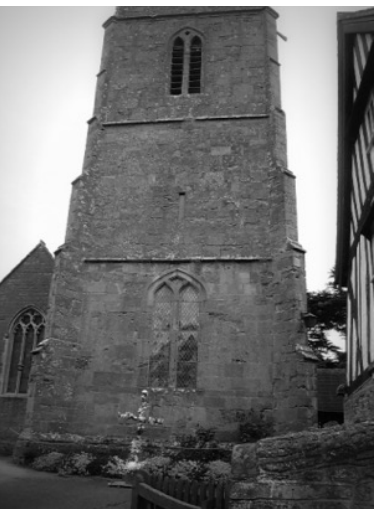
- The first phase includes the tower restoration work and this could cost up to £200,000
- Comprehensive repairs are needed to the internal walls.
- Restoration of several stained glass windows is required.
- Facilities within the church are in urgent need of repair and updating.



The church that stands in the middle of Redmarley village is the 2nd or even 3rd building to occupy this site, the earliest reference being made to a church here in 1290.

Dedicated to St. Bartholomew it is Grade II* listed, with the base of the tower being the oldest part.

It is this part of the building that the church's rich heritage is evident. During the Civil War, and the battle of Redmarley in 1644 the troops would sharpen their weapons on the sandstone walls prior to going into battle.
