MINUTES of the ADDITIONAL ORDINARY MEETING OF REDMARLEY PARISH COUNCIL held on Wednesday 29th April 2026 at 7.00pm at Redmarley Village Hall in The Ian Smith Room

MINUTES

Present: Cllr Josh Wheeler (Chair), Cllr Jeff Wheeler and Cllr Ken Leech. [All will be referred to by their initials or first name and initial of surname]

In Attendance: Leo Williams (Clerk), County Cllr Gill Moseley [GM] and one [member of the public [MoP]]. The meeting started at 7.02pm.

- 152. Apologies for Absence** - District Cllr Phillip Burford.
- 153. Declarations of Interest** - None.
- 154. Co-option of New Member** - None.
- 155. Public Consultation** – The MoP voiced strong support for the decision of the council to allow the newly formed Redmarley FC to use the playing field.
The chairman granted GM dispensation to discuss the following matters: **(i)** The members' local highways budgets has been absorbed into the Highways Manager's budgets. **(ii)** The administration are striving to ensure more proper patching and resurfacing happens instead of just filling potholes. **(iii)** There is still £10,000 left in GM's Grass Roots Community Fund. **(iv)** Local Government restructuring: A decision on the future council make up in Gloucestershire is anticipated to be published in June or July.
- 156. Local Plan Update** – The MoP confirmed that United Against Glynchbrook were now in a waiting phase although vital fundraising was ongoing. They thanked the council for its contribution. The council is aware of a letter from Black Box Planning to all FoDDC members and the letter was read by the clerk. It was agreed to offer no response at this time.
- 157. Planning Responses** - **(i)** P0313/26/FUL Camp Farm, Drury Lane, Redmarley, GL19 3JX. Change of use of land and existing agricultural building from agricultural to mixed agricultural and equestrian. There were **no objections**, but the Council will request that planning permission be made **conditional** upon the full reopening of Public Right of Way GRA29 along its definitive line.
(ii) P0365/26/FUL Fernley House, Pendock Road, Redmarley, GL19 3LG. Erection of single storey side extension incorporating existing garaging to create ancillary living accommodation. There were **no objections**, but the council will request that any permission includes a **condition** preventing the accommodation from being rented out.

- 158 PROW Issues** - Josh W reported that in spite of continued reports GRA42, GRA46 and GRA75 remain blocked at various locations around Playley Green Farm. After discussion it was resolved to commence proceedings under S130.6 Highways Act 1980. A letter will be sent and the GCC Chief Executive will be copied in.
